MEWS, SW1, £5.25M**

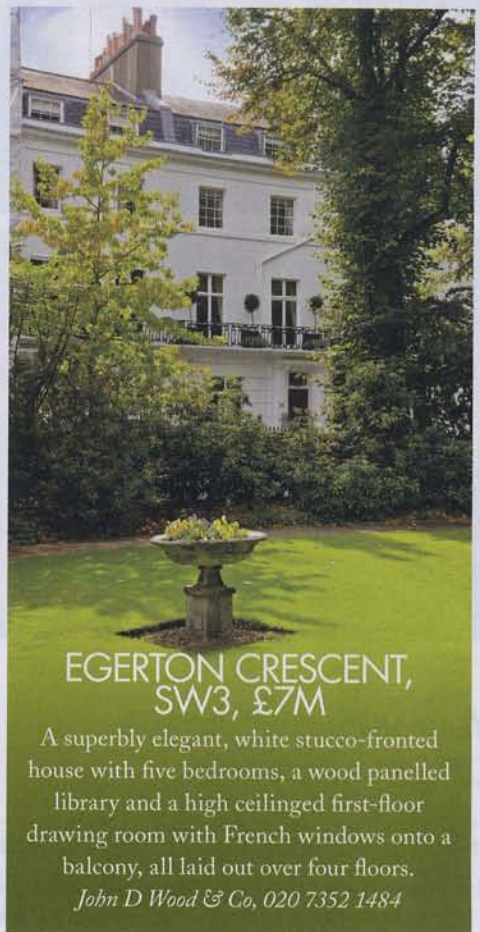
Not one, but three car parking spaces come
